### Check list when registering

- Catchment area** – Please check that you are within our boundary by going to our website [www.wansfordsurgery.co.uk](http://www.wansfordsurgery.co.uk) and clicking 'REGISTER' then 'practice catchment area'. Click on the map and enter your postcode. A message will be displayed letting you know whether you are within our boundary.
- Photographic ID** – Please bring photographic ID to show at reception such as:
- Passport
  - Driving licence
- (Only 16 years of age and over)
- Proof of address** – Please provide proof of address. This must contain your new address and your name. Suitable documents are:
- Council tax form
  - Solicitors letter
  - Bank statement
- (Only 16 years of age and over)
- GMS1 form (purple form)** – Please sign at the base of form. Complete both sides
- New patient questionnaire PLUS AUDIT C questionnaire**
- Details of current/repeat medication.** This should be an official printout from your previous practice. You may need to see a GP to have medications added.
- Online patient access** – If you would like to book an appointment or order repeat prescriptions online please fill in the Online Access form.
- Your 'health record and sharing of information' form** – Please complete this form. This determines whether other health care providers (e.g. minor injury unit, out of hours etc.) can see your GP record. This information is NOT shared with anyone else.
- Summary care record opt-out form** – If you would like to opt- out of sharing your record please fill in the opt-out form (Please read the enclosed letter)

**PLEASE NOTE WE REQUIRE ALL THE ABOVE INFORMATION IN ORDER TO REGISTER YOU. REGISTRATION WILL TAKE APPROXIMATELY 5 WORKING DAYS. We do not offer new patient health checks but you may be eligible for a free NHS health check. Please ask at reception.**
